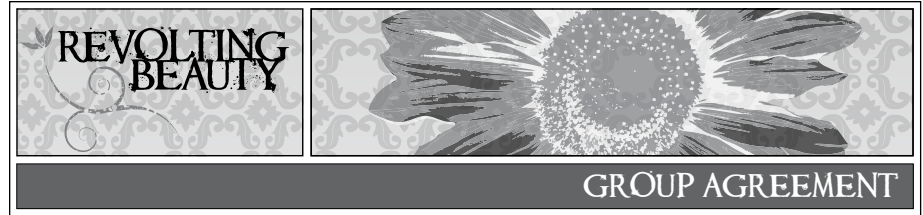




1. Be accepting of others in your group by listening intently.

SERVE ONE ANOTHER: *"For you were called to freedom, brethren; only (do) not (turn) your freedom into opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another." –Gal. 5:13*
FORGIVE ONE ANOTHER: *"And be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you." –Eph. 4:32*
BE PATIENT WITH ONE ANOTHER: *"Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love." –Eph. 4:2*
SUBMIT TO ONE ANOTHER: *"Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ." –Eph. 5:21*
ENCOURAGE ONE ANOTHER: *"...let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds." –Heb. 10:24*
OFFER HOSPITALITY: *"Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. Each one should use whatever gift he has to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms." –1 Pet. 4:9-10*

ACCEPT BOUNDARIES. While we will be accessible and accountable to one another, we will respect one another's personal and family boundaries.

BE OPEN AND HONEST. We will seek to be open and honest with each other. Our group is a place where we can take off our masks and be truly ourselves, and be accepted for whom we are.

ASSUME OWNERSHIP: This is God's group. (It is not the "leader's group" or the "host's group"!) As parts of the body of Christ, we will all share responsibility for the group's mission, values and goals.
